

ORDERING BOOKS

After you've registered for a course, you can find the books needed on the course info page in Populi. Click on the book title and you will be shown the bibliographic information for the book.

Though we don't endorse any particular online bookstore, most, if not all, of our required books can be found at **amazon.com** where you can check for prices and what a particular edition includes. Your ".edu" student email address allows you to get Amazon Prime at a 50% discount. Amazon Prime provides FREE, 2-day shipping on many books.

At any particular site, you can search for books by typing in the ISBN identification listed for each book on the booklist. Note that the ISBN is either ten or thirteen digits long and might include a letter. **Before purchasing used books be sure to check that the edition is correct.** Many times you will find very cheap textbooks, but they might be an older edition. **Also, be aware if the instructor has selected an edition that comes with a CD/DVD.** You'll want to be sure that it will come with your purchase of a used book.

As you order your books, **you can have them shipped directly to Providence after August 1.** We'll hold onto them until you arrive. That way you won't have to carry all that extra weight. Please use the following mailing address for your books:
